CONSTITUTION REVIEW FORUMS WITH CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICERS/DIRECTORS/BUSINESS LEADERS OF AAK MEMBER COMPANIES



The technical team that reviewed the constitution held successive breakfast meetings with chief executive officers/directors/business leaders of AAK member companies to highlight key issues/changes being made on the constitution. The forums took place in 3 phases i.e. Breakfast meeting with multinational companies which was held on 06 September 2017 at AAK Office, meeting with local companies held on Friday, 08 September 2017 and an all industry meeting which took place on 12th September 2017 at Radisson Blu Hotel, Nairobi. In all these meetings, members' views were heard and incorporated in the constitution.

The forums targeted only chief executive officers, directors or heads of AAK member Companies as a way of ensuring that the owners of the industry take control and ownership of the constitution.

During the industry breakfast meetings held on 12th September 2017 at the Radisson Blu Hotel, Nairobi, The Chief Executive Officer, Ms. Evelyn Lusenaka during her opening remarks informed the meeting that the current constitution was developed over 25 years ago and has been reviewed twice with last review being 2013. She



reiterated that quite a number of things have changed since the Old Constitution was enacted.



The Vice Chair of the Association, Mr. Amuyunzu, who chaired the session noted that the Agrochem Industry is changing and that it is high time the industry reviewed its

governance structure and its direction in the coming years. He reiterated the importance of members of the Association getting involved in moving the Association forward and contributing towards progressive change. Mr. Amuyunzu took members present through the changes proposed by AAK members and incorporated in the constitution by the review team.

He informed the meeting that the Constitution Review Team made a number of changes which was going to affect how the Association is governed. The new constitution aims to ensure members participation in AAK. The team also looked at inclusivity, diversity, growth and changes that are occurring to ensure service delivery to members.
